

Plan with Priorities, Not Pinterest

Define your top three priorities early (e.g., photography, food, and venue). Focus spending on what matters most.

Book Local Vendors

Local suppliers avoid travel and accommodation costs. Hiring nearby photographers, florists, or caterers can save significantly.

Off-Peak and Weekday Weddings

Venues and photographers often offer 10–30% discounts midweek or during the winter months (May–August).

Simplify Your Guest List

Each additional guest can add R800–R1,500 on average. Smaller, more intimate weddings save money and stress.

DIY Where It Counts (Not Everywhere)

DIY stationery, signage, or favours can save costs, but avoid DIY catering or photography to prevent unnecessary stress.

Combine Services

Ask about package deals, like combined photo + video or engagement + wedding bundles. Photav.io suppliers often offer discounts.
